After the potluck, a representative from Governor Snyder's office will provide information on "What Services the State can Provide for Seniors."



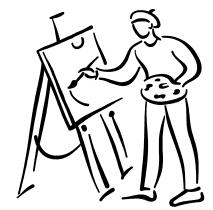

- 4. Ask your bank manager to train tellers on how to detect elder financial abuse.
