Do you take care of a spouse, a partner, or another family member? Have you considered how to help your loved one make important decisions about their finances, health, and legal affairs if they become incapacitated? Many people think that their only option to help with decision-making is to get a guardianship, but there are alternatives, many of which are less burdensome for those providing the care, and better for those we take care of too. Come to this training, presented by Legal Services of South Central Michigan, to help you think through your options.
