Lori's Hands creates intergenerational service learning partnerships. Students make weekly visits to community members with chronic illness to assist with daily activities and, in turn, learn about the real life experience of chronic disease.

Who is eligible to become a Lori's Hands client?

An individual who: lives in the greater Ypsilanti/Ann Arbor area, has a diagnosed chronic disease, can accept a weekly visit from volunteers during the academic semester, and is open to answering student questions about health & healthcare experiences.

Who are the Lori's Hands interns and volunteers?

Eastern Michigan University students in good standing who demonstrate genuine interest in healthcare and service.

What services are offered?

Grocery shopping, yard work, light cleaning & organizing, friendly visits, and more!

What services are not offered?

Transportation, medical & personal care, bill paying, caregiving for people who aren't safe to be alone.
