For years, activists have been pushing for the county to establish a dedicated funding source for senior services. According to the US 2020 Census, there are over 72,000 people in Washtenaw County age 60 or older and they are the county's fastest growing age demographic. There is overwhelming support among trustees to send the millage to the voters, with the end goal to create a Washtenaw County Office on Aging. The .5 mills would be in effect for eight years through 2031. For more information, please plan on attending the potluck.

Also joining us at the potluck will be representatives from the **Social Action Committee of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority**. They will have resource materials available, and address questions regarding the voting process.

The YSC is in the preliminary stages of planning for building remodeling and patio renovations. **Architectural firm Synecdoche** will join us at the potluck to discuss upcoming focus groups that will discuss member thoughts about needed spaces at the center. 
