The **Ypsilanti Senior Center** is one of ten senior centers located in Washtenaw County. 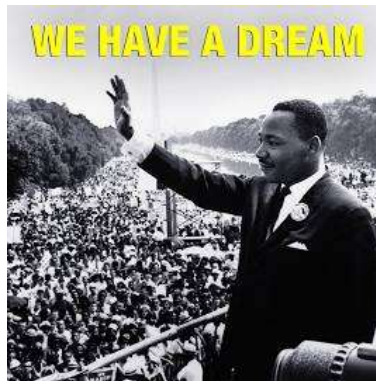
